

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Modification of the Procurement Integrated Enterprise Environment (PIEE)'s Notification Uniform Resource Locators (URLs)

1. ACTION REQUIRED: It is imperative that this information be given widest distribution within your Agency/Service/Command, to the lowest level, and that you encourage your end-user to coordinate this change as soon as possible, no Later Than JULY 1, 2020

2. BACKGROUND: The Procurement Integrated Enterprise Environment (PIEE) Program Management Office will be migrating the modular components that comprise the PIEE environment (to include the Wide Area Workflow (WAWF) application) from the current Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) hosting environment to the Amazon Web Services (AWS) cloud hosting environment on July 1, 2020.

3. FACTS: No later than July 1, 2020, in order to access the PIEE environment and its underlying applications without interruption, your Service/Agency/Command enterprise level information technology (IT) department or network administrator will need to update the trusted sites and the enterprise Java "whitelist" file (Java deployment rule set feature) to include the new URL's identified below. This action is required because DoD/corporate end-users are, for security purposes, restricted from modifying computer or network access settings in order to add these trusted sites. Failure take the action to add these URLs to your trusted sites will result in a denial of access and impact the day-to-day business processes that utilize the PIEE and the underlying applications identified below.
